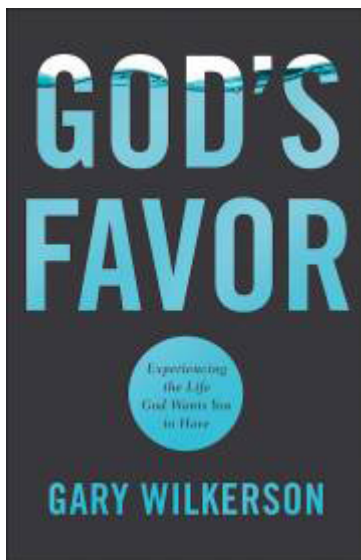
What Jesus is pursuing in meeting our felt needs is a deeper understanding and relationship with the triune God.
